No volunteers may enter

## STEP 2

**SEPT 22-OCT 5**

Subject to change\*

### VISITORS /FAMILIES

Outdoor Visits (weather  
permitting) scheduled in  
advance, held in pre-  
determined neutral zones on  
campus. One visitor per  
resident with a time limit.  
Supervised. Screening, hand  
hygiene, distancing, masks

### COMMUNAL DINING

Dining in small groups with  
6-ft distance. Staff wear PPE

### ACTIVITIES

Supervised activities in groups  
up to 10 with 6-ft distance,  
masks, hand hygiene

### OUTINGS

No outings in Step 2

### NON ESSENTIAL STAFF

NE Staff may enter.  
Screened, provided PPE &  
infection control education

### VOLUNTEERS

No volunteers may enter

## STEP 3

**BEGINS OCT 6**

Subject to change\*



Indoor & Outdoor Visits  
(weather permitting)  
scheduled in advance, held  
in pre-determined neutral  
zones on campus. One  
visitor per resident with a  
time limit. Supervised.  
Screening, hand hygiene,  
distancing, masks required



Dining in small groups ,  
6-ft distance. Staff wear PPE



Supervised, expanded  
activities in groups of 10+  
Distanced, masks, hand  
hygiene



Chaperoned outings,  
limited two per month,  
5 people total. Distanced,  
masks, hand hygiene



NE Staff may enter.  
Screened, provided PPE &  
infection control education



Vols may enter. Screened,  
PPE, distanced, hand hygiene

\*Any COVID onset requires a return to restricted status; reopening steps require COVID-free environment in 14-day increments; no one with a positive COVID result may participate; additional restrictions may apply.
